Elaine Paul



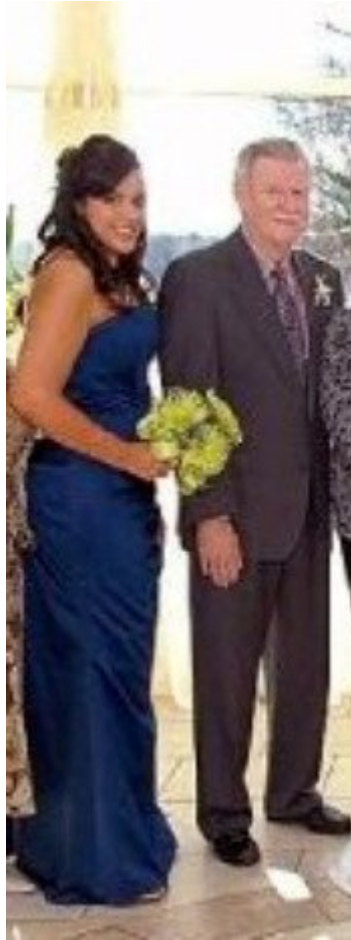
